Fishing Tips - Getting Ready for Fishing Opener

This month's Tips column will focus more on reminders and checklists for getting ready for the summer fishing season. We hope and pray that there will be a summer fishing season! Even though the Minnesota Governor's Fishing Opener celebration was postponed for a year, Minnesota Gov. Walz said that he will be out fishing on opener, obeying of course safe social distancing!

With all that is going on in this world, it would be good to stop for a minute and thank God for the world of nature He has given to us and to pray for the safety and health of our families, friends and neighbors. I thank God too for all healthcare workers and the support staff behind them that are caring for people with COVID-19.

Fishing Equipment

Check rods: guides should not be bent; no cracks or grooves in guide inserts (from braided line mostly) – one of my rods mysteriously lost an insert over the winter! Fix rods with broken tips or just move the tip off the broken section onto the end of the rod.

Check reels: Re-spool reels that have mono line (see March post). Clean and lube reels; if you do not do this yourself, get it into the shop NOW before they get backlogged. See link below for a list of reel schematics.

<u>Tackle/Gear:</u> Early on the water will be cold; slow your presentations down; bring cold weather clothes.

The Boat

<u>Safety:</u> Check life jackets for wear. If you have auto PFDs, check the bobbins and cartridges. Note too that Wisconsin has different regulations for wearing them than does Minnesota. If you fish Lake Superior make sure your flares are up to date.

<u>Electrical</u>: Check your Nav lights, pumps, fuses, etc. Check your batteries to make sure they are in good shape for boating season. There are some good sales now on marine batteries. Find your electronics! Remount your transducers if you take them off for the winter.

Motor: Get fresh gas in your tank. Your motor may not even start with old gas in the tank. If you need to pump out and dispose of old gas, Harbor Freight sells a handy little battery powered fuel pump to pump it out. Old gas can be recycled at Bay West or other recycling centers. See the link below for non-oxy gas stations in MN. Consider installing new spark plugs and creating a maintenance log if you don't have one. Finally, check your motor with the garden hose and muffs to make sure the water pump works (water should come out of the "pee hole"). Make sure your trolling motor and remote work too.



If You Can't Wait for Walleye/Northern Opener in May

- 1) Fish now for crappies and perch shallow; Mississippi River Pool 4 for walleyes and sauger.
- 2) Explore the MN DNR Lake Finder web site; there is some great information out there on MN lakes.
- 3) Read up on the DNR regulations and changes for 2020; download the regs to your phone.
- 4) Get a license if you have not already! (Required for ages 16-89).
- 5) Organize your tackle box; make sure you have extra swivels, snaps, bobber stops, sinkers, etc.
- 6) Make some jigs/lures (see me if you want to pour some lead I have lots of molds and non-toxic "lead")

Ingredients:

- 10 Walleye Fillets
- 2 tsp. Honey
- 2 Cups of coarsely crushed crackers
- 1 egg, slightly beaten
- 1/3 Cup Flour
- 2 teaspoon salt

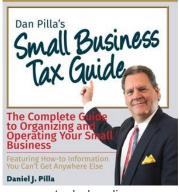
