

Reel Hope Youth Fishing Program

- Cultivates Relationships
- Explores New Skills
- Transforms Lives

This multi-phase program is designed to reduce the likelihood of at-risk youth becoming involved in crime by fostering positive relationships and connections with the great outdoors through fishing. The program is divided into three one-day events, each corresponding to the Build, Explore, and Transform phases, which build upon one another and introduce new skills for handling everyday stressors and techniques for outdoor activities.



All equipment and tackle is provided by Fishing For Life.

WHO:

• Youth Ages 11-17 | Male and Female

WHAT:

• One-day youth events with community engagement and adult mentorship.

BUILD PHASE:

Each participant will learn how to restore rods, reels, and tackleboxes. All participants keep the equipment they restore.

EXPLORE PHASE:

A guided fishing event on a nearby lake with fishing instruction for the youth.*

TRANSFORM PHASE:

All-expenses-paid fishing trip on a chartered boa

All-expenses-paid fishing trip on a chartered boat on one of Minnesota's large fishing lakes.*

*Participants MUST complete the Build and Explore phases to be eligible for the Transform phase. Fishing Licenses for those 16 and older will be paid for by Fishing For Life.
