We would also like to address the holistic nature of help to include physical, spiritual and emotional well-being with follow-up activities and options veterans can take home. To this extent, we may have FFL, Veterans Affairs (VA), Wounded Warrior Project (WWP), pastoral leadership representation and great fishing guides joining us!

To help us facilitate these goals and as a veteran and representative of the United States of America and Fishing for Life, your understanding of appropriate behavior is essential. It is our hope as Fishing for Life to bring veterans together in the great outdoors. Furthermore, we want to foster an environment where longstanding relationships can develop, and loom the whole veteran's health with physical, emotional, and spiritual growth.

Below is our list of requirements that help foster such an environment.

Please take note of the following:

1. Appropriate attire is expected at all events. Clothing with crude or inappropriate graphics/text will not be permitted.
2. Please be mindful of the language you are using. Excessive/Inappropriate profanity will not be tolerated.
3. Should you have any questions or concerns about an event, or about another participant, please contact a FFL employee. Be respectful of other veterans.
4. While individuals of age are permitted to consume alcohol purchased at their own expense at certain events, your level of intoxication should never prohibit you from acting in an appropriate manner. We also encourage you to get plenty of sleep and watch the late-night activities.
5. FFL staff, vendors, and volunteers work hard to make each event take place. Please be aware of this and treat these individuals with appreciation and respect.
6. Anything that is deemed inappropriate, derogatory, or disrespectful by a FFL staff member is grounds for dismissal.
7. If any of you should decide to go back to the event area or facility at a later time, please remember to patronize the establishments that made this all possible.
